Step up your future



Intended Audience: Year 10 & 11 Intended Session Length: 1 hour

This session will encourage students to begin thinking about their dream career and understand the possible steps they can take towards this. They will also begin to learn independent skills so as to when they may leave home whether that be for University or further down the line the transition to independent living will be as smooth as possible.

The

game is loosely based around the 'Crystal Maze' incorporating physical, mental, skill and mystery games with healthy competitive spirit. They will gain knowledge of specific terms which will be used throughout their educational journey, whilst gaining valuable team work skills and life skills along the way. They will apply this practically to gain a much deeper understanding and retain this knowledge.

This workshop aims to prepare students to become much more self-sufficient and make choices to suit them and want they want to achieve.

Session outcome: To be more aware of skills they need to develop to reach future goals.
